

Q1 2024 revenues

- Revenue EUR 160.4m (EUR -10.8m or -6.3% vs LY)
 - Decrease in chartering revenues due to less vessels on charter
 - Strong result in ticket sales segment
- Profitability impacted by the sale of the cruise ferry Isabelle
- EBITDA of EUR 34.5m (EUR +7.4m or 27.2% vs LY)
- Net profit of EUR 2.6m (EUR 8.0m or 147.4% vs LY)
- CAPEX of EUR 6.3m (EUR -5.2m or -45.0% vs LY)
 - Majority of investments were related to maintenance and repair of vessels






Sales by operational segments Q1 2024

REVENUE STRUCTURE Q1 2024⁽¹⁾










Passenger (millions)



Revenue (in million euros)




Cargo (th. units)





EBITDA (in million euros)










Total interest-bearing liabilities of EUR 630.0 million
