


HIGHLIGHTS OF Q2 2011

- TEO was awarded as a Socially Responsible Enterprise, The Best Employer and The Most Environment Friendly Enterprise during National Responsible Business Awards 2010













VOICE TELEPHONY SERVICES






- During January-June 2011, the total number of main telephone lines in service decreased by 17.6 thousand, while over the last twelve months – by 31.6 thousand lines.
- Total traffic volume generated by residential and business customers decreased by 5.6 and 11.4 per cent, respectively
- In March 2011, TEO has offered major business enterprises and organisations its cloud computingbased voice telephony service – Virtual IP PBX

INTERNET SERVICES





- During January-June 2011, the total number of broadband Internet access users increased by 8.8 thousand, while over the last twelve months – by 23.3 thousand
- 119 thousand of fiber optical (FTTB, FTTH) connections
- 32 thousand WiFi connection users
- 3,640 WiFi hot-spots network –
 the largest in the country
- Almost 50% of Lithuania's direct international Internet traffic goes through TEO connections






Revenue breakdown by segments





TEO MARKET SHARE IN TERMS OF REVENUE (Q1 2011)



- 35 companies are using IP network, 18 of them CATV and data communication networks
- Number of alternative operators' subscribers: 67.7 thousand or 9.1% of total subscribers' number
- TEO market share (Q1 2011) in terms of:
 - total number of customers: 90.9%
 - total traffic: 95.5%
 - revenue from local calls: 98.9%
 - revenue from domestic long distance calls: 88.2%
 - revenue from international calls: 72.6%








Breakdown of revenue for H1 2011





- Capital investments during H1 2011 amounted to LTL 63 million (LTL 51 million in 2010)
- LTL 58 million went to expansion of the core network and fiber-optic access network
- LTL 4 million was invested into IT systems and LTL 1 million into renovation of premises
- In June 2011 TEO opened a new customer care centre
- In May the Company paid out LTL 140 million of dividends of for the year 2010 (i.e. 0.18 litas per share)

- In June 2011, TeliaSonera AB (publ) took over from its subsidiary Amber Teleholding A/S a controlling interest in TEO and now directly holds a 68.08% stake in the Company
- Republic of Lithuania, represented by State Property Fund, reduced its holding in TEO from 3,075,315 (31-Dec-2010) to 2,047 (30-Jun-2011) shares
- As of 30 June 2011, Republic of Lithuania, represented by State Tax Inspectorate, held 362,630 shares
- In total, the Republic of Lithuania has 364,677 shares of the Company








TRADING IN **TEO** SHARES ON NASDAQ OMX VILNIUS STOCK EXCHANGE IN 2011






TEO SHARE AND NASDAQ OMX VILNIUS STOCK EXCHANGE INDEXES COMPARISON
