Explanatory notes

NOTE 1 GENERAL INFORMATION

AB Ūkio bankas ("The Bank") was established in June 1989 as Commercial Industry Bank. The Bank's main office is located in Kaunas, Maironio str. 25.

The Bank has a business license issued from Bank of Lithuania for conducting all financial services specified by Lithuanian Banks Law and providing other services allowed under Lithuanian Financial Institutions Law.

The Bank has 12 branches and 38 client service departments in Lithuania and 3 representative offices in foreign countries. In addition, the Bank has, directly or indirectly, 8 subsidiaries, UAB Ūkio Banko Lizingas, set up in 1997, UAB Turto Valdymo Strategija, UAB Turto Valdymo Sprendimai and UAB Turto Valdymo Sistemos, set up in 2004, UAB Ūkio Banko Investicijų Valdymas set up in 2006, and UAB Ūkio Banko Rizikos Kapitalo Valdymas set up in 2007. OAO Russkij Karavaj (Russia), acquired in 2005 with 75% of shares owned by UAB Turto Valdymo Strategija and UAB Ūkio Banko Lizingas has set up RAB Ūkio Bank Lizing (Ukraine) in 2006.

As of 30 September 2007 the Group and the Bank employed 713 and 617 employees respectively (as of 31 December 2006: 572 and 504).

NOTE 2 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies applied by the Group and the Bank in these condensed interim financial statements are the same as those applied by the Group and the Bank in their financial statements as at and for the year ended 31 December 2006, which were prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRSs") as adopted by the EU and International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS"), respectively. IFRSs as adopted by the EU do not currently differ from IFRS as issued by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) and currently effective for the purpose of these financial statements, except for certain hedge accounting requirements under IAS 39, which have not been adopted by the EU. The Group and the Bank has determined that the unendorsed hedge accounting requirements under IAS 39 would not impact the Bank's and the consolidated financial statements had they been endorsed by the EU at the balance sheet date.

The condensed interim financial statements for the Group and the Bank have been prepared in accordance with IAS 34, *Interim Financial Reporting*, as adopted by the EU and IAS 34, *Interim Financial Reporting*, respectively. Condensed interim financial statements such as these do not include information as extensive as annual financial statements compiled in accordance with IFRSs as adopted by the EU or IFRS and should be read in conjunction with the Group's and the Bank's annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2006

The Group and the Bank has adopted IFRS 7, *Financial Instruments: Disclosures*, from annual periods beginning 1 January 2007. For the purpose of these condensed interim financial statements all disclosures as required by IFRS 7 have not been disclosed. Full disclosures as required by IFRS 7 will be disclosed in the Annual Financial Statements for the year 2007.

The Condensed Interim Financial Statements are presented in Lithuanian Litas (LTL), rounded to the nearest thousand.

NOTE 3 SEASONALITY OF THE RESULTS

No significant amounts of the Group's and the Bank's income or expenses are of a seasonal nature.

NOTE 10 SHARE CAPITAL

The authorized capital of the Bank as of 30 September 2007 was LTL'000 196,708 and consisted of 196,708,000 ordinary shares with par value of LTL 1 each. All shares are fully paid.

On 22 March 2007, dividends in respect of 2006 of LTL 0.01 per share amounting to total of LTL'000 1,767 were proposed (dividends paid as of 30 September 2007 amounted to LTL'000 1,743).

MAIN INDICATORS OF ACTIVITY:

- AB Ūkio bankas group continues to improve its results of activity. During nine months of 2007 Ūkio bankas Group earned net profit of LTL 61.5 million i.e. twice as much as during the same period of previous year.
- Since the beginning of 2007, Ūkio bankas opened 4 new client service departments. As of 30 September 2007, the Bank's service network consisted of 50 outlets 12 branches and 38 client service departments. Bank also has 3 representative offices in Kiev (Ukraine), Moscow (Russia) and Almaty (Kazakhstan).
- Ükio bank's market share by assets among Lithuanian commercial banks and foreign banks' branches increased from 5.1 percent in the beginning of 2007 to 5.4 percent in the end of third quarter of 2007. Bank's market share by deposits increased from 7.0 percent to 7.7 percent during the same period.
- The Bank's 100 percent owned leasing subsidiary UAB Ūkio banko lizingas offers its services through over 2.5 thousand sales points located throughout entire Lithuania. As of 30 September 2007, UAB Ūkio banko lizingas had 182 thousand customers i.e. the number of customers increased by 9 percent y-o-y.
- The Bank's 100 percent owned subsidiary UAB Ūkio banko investicijų valdymas increased the spectre of savings products offered by Ūkio bankas group by establishing second investment fund – Ūkio bankas rational investment fund.

CREDIT RATINGS

24 February 2007 international rating agency Moody's upgraded ratings of Ūkio bankas up to:

- Deposit rating Ba3/NP (previously B1/NP);
- Financial strength rating D- (previously E+).

The perspective of both ratings is stable.



On 7 September 2007, the international rating agency Standard&Poor's for the first time assigned ratings to $\bar{\text{U}}$ kio bankas:

Long-term counterparty credit rating BB.

Short-term counterparty credit rating B.

The outlook for both ratings is stable.

INCOME

As compared to the income of the nine-month period in 2006, income of AB $\bar{\text{U}}$ kio bankas Group increased by LTL 52 million or 40% up to LTL 184 million. Increased in interest-earning assets caused the growth of net interest income by 64% up to LTL 85 million. They made the largest share of Group's income – 46%. Growth in number of clients, increased activity of clients and number of operations caused net fee and commission income of the Group to increase by 36% up to LTL 76 million i.e. 41% of Group's income. Trading income increased by LTL 1 million and made 12% of Group's income. Other income decreased by 58% down to LTL 1 million and made 1% of the Group's income.

EXPENSES

Intensive expansion of AB Ūkio bankas group, growth in assets and service network, growth in number of clients and operations caused the increase in operating expenses of the Group by LTL 39 million compared to the same period of the previous year up to LTL 100 million in nine months of 2007. 28 percent of these expenses consisted of staff expenses, which increased by LTL 8 million up to LTL 28 million.

The Group's provision expenses decreased 71% down to LTL 10 million, income tax expenses increased 2.1 times up to LTL 12 million.

ASSETS

During first nine months of 2007, Group's assets increased by LTL 1.05 billion or 33% and made LTL 4.25 billion as of 30 September 2007. The largest share of Group's assets -40% - consisted of net loans to customers, which increased by LTL 874 million (i.e. twice) from the beginning of the year and made LTL 1.71 billion as of 30 September 2007. Due from banks and other financial institutions, comprising 21% of Group's assets, increased by 2% from the beginning of the year and made LTL 905 million as of 30 September 2007. Securities portfolio increased by 9% from the beginning of the year and made LTL 718 million i.e. 17% of Group's assets.

IMPAIRMENT OF ASSETS

Grouping of loans granted by AB Ūkio bankas Group according to the Minimal Loan Assessment Requirements approved by the Bank of Lithuania revealed that as of 30 September 2007:

- Book value of loans for which, a loss event and an impairment loss has occurred, made 6.4 percent of the book value of Group's loan portfolio;
- Discounted cash flows from the collateral for the loans for which a loss event and an impairment loss has occurred made 50.2 percent of the nominal value of these loans;
- Provision for the impairment of Group's loans of LTL 53.6 million is formed. It makes 31.3 percent of the nominal value of the loans for which a loss event and an impairment loss has occurred and 2.8 percent of the nominal value of the Group's loan portfolio;
- A major part of the loans for which a loss event and an impairment loss has occurred consists of loans for which a loss event is recognized not because of payment delays, but because of the conservative assessment of the financial status of the borrower. Book value of the loans that have payment delays of 60 or more days makes up 0.68 percent of the book value of the whole loan portfolio.

At 30 September 2007, for the investments held to maturity, no loss event has occurred and no provision was made. Provisions for the impairment of other assets amounted to LTL 11.0 million i.e. 1.1 percent of other assets. No impairment of the off-balance sheet items was detected, and no provisions against the impairment of off-balance sheet items were formed.

LIABILITIES AND EQUITY

As of 30 September 2007, deposits from customers made 63% of liabilities and equity of the Group. From the beginning of the year, they increased by LTL 539 million or 25% and made LTL 2.66 billion as of 30 September 2007.



Due to banks and other financial institutions made 21% of Group's liabilities and equity. From the beginning of the year, they increased by 49% and made LTL 876 million as of 30 September 2007. Group's equity increased by 30% from the beginning of the year and made LTL 502 million i.e. 12% of Group's liabilities and equity as of 30 September 2007.

MATERIAL EVENTS IN AB ŪKIO BANKAS ACTIVITIES

On 3 July 2007 AB $\overline{\text{U}}$ kio bankas announced about increasing of the shareholding up to 100 of GD UAB Bonum Publicum stock.

On 3 July 2007 AB Ūkio bankas informed about the Board of Ūkio bankas decision to approve the decision of the Bank's subsidiary UAB Turto valdymo strategija to acquire AAB Ruskij karavaj's new issue of 14.5 million ordinary registered shares for the total of 58,000,000 roubles and in this way increase its shareholding up to 99.03 percent.

On 13 July 2007 AB Ūkio bankas announced non-audited net profit of the first half of year 2007 - LTL 50.0 million (EUR 14.5 million). Main reasons that caused faster than planned increase of the profit of AB Ūkio bankas are: increased volume of assets; increased number of customers and operations; reversal of provisions formed against several large positions.

On 23 July 2007 AB Ūkio bankas announced that offering of new issue of ordinary registered shares of LTL 20 million (EUR 5.79 million) has been completed. 20 million of shares at the par value of LTL 1 (EUR 0.29 EUR) were subscribed and paid in full:

- 18,669,980 shares were subscribed and paid in Stage 1;
- 1,303,264 shares were subscribed and paid in Stage 2;
- 26,756 shares were subscribed and paid in Stage 3.

Subscribed and paid shares will be issued to investors after amendments of the Bank's articles of association in relation to the increase of the authorized capital are registered as provided for by the Law and the shares are entered into the issuer's AB Ūkio bankas books.

On 31 July 2007 AB Ūkio bankas announced Group consolidated unaudited net profit of first half of year 2007 - LTL 45.1 million (EUR 13.1 million).

On 10 August 2007 AB Ūkio bankas announced unaudited net profit of first seven months of year 2007 - LTL 55.4 million (EUR 16.0 million).

On 10 August 2007 AB Ūkio bankas announced that Statute with increased authorized share capital has been registered with the Register of legal entities. After increase the Bank's authorized share capital amounts to LTL 196 708 00 (EUR 56.97 milion). One share has a nominal value of LTL 1 (EUR 0.29).

On 7 September 2007 Bankas informed that international rating agency "Standard&Poor's" for the first time assigned its ratings to AB Ūkio Bankas: it received the 'BB' long- and 'B' short-term counterparty credit ratings. The outlook for both ratings is stable.

On 10 September 2007 AB Ūkio bankas announced year 2007 eight months result and revised annual forecast. AB Ūkio bankas unaudited net profit of first eight months of year 2007 is LTL 61.3 million (EUR 17.8 million). Revised profit forecast of AB Ūkio bankas for the year 2007 is LTL 82 million (EUR 23.7 million).
